STEWARDS REPORT

SEOUL RACECOURSE

Sunday 29th November 2009

Weather: Occasional light showers

Track: 4% (races 1-2); 6% (races 3-5); 7% (races 6-9); 8% (races 10-11)

Stewards: Il-ki Chang (Chairman), James Perry, In-wook Hwang, T B Oh

RACE ONE: CLASS 5 - DOMESTIC BRED - 1200 METRES

HWASINDO was difficult to load in the barrier and must now undergo a stall test prior to its next start. When questioned, Kim Hae Sun (MUGYEOLJEOM) stated that she was instructed to ride the filly where comfortable but preferably in a midfield position. She stated that the filly did not begin as well as expected and raced further back than expected. Stewards expressed their concern with the ride in the early stages and Kim Hae Sun was told that her ride was not acceptable in that there was an opportunity to improve her position in the early stages of the race in order to obtain a midfield position as instructed. Kim Hae Sun, given her relative inexperience, was given a severe warning in respect to her ride and was advised against a repetition. FREYJA hung out badly when racing in the home straight and a warning was issued. Yoon Tae Hyoung (DAEMYEONGJANG) was fined W20,000 for carelessly allowing his mount to shift in near the 800m when not clear of HWASINDO which was momentarily checked.

RACE TWO: CLASS 6 - DOMESTIC BRED - 1000 METRES

A post race veterinary examination of **GEUMGANGNARU** and **VICTORY SONG** did not reveal any abnormality. A post race veterinary examination of **YONGILCHEON** revealed the filly to be lame in the near fore leg. Acting on veterinary advice **YONGILCHEON** will be ineligible to race for one month. Shin Hyoung Chul (**JEOLMEUN HYANGGI**) was warned for carelessly allowing his mount to shift in near the 850m when not clear of **LADY HUNTER** which had to be eased across its heels. A swab sample was taken from **YONGILCHEON**.

RACE THREE: CLASS 6 – DOMESTIC BRED – 1000 METRES

UNO MISSILE was difficult to load in the barrier and must now undergo a stall test prior to its next start. A post race veterinary examination of ELEVEN HERO did not reveal any abnormality. ELEVEN HERO recorded a time outside the qualifying time of 1.07 and will now be required to re-qualify in an official barrier trial prior to its next start. A post race veterinary examination of WORLD CLASSIC did not reveal any abnormality. In the home straight DESCENTE hung in for which a warning was issued. Lee Dong Kug (JUOKGADEUN) was warned for carelessly allowing his mount to shift in near the 900m when not clear of WORLD CLASSIC which was carried in for a short

distance. Near the 850m **WORLD CLASSIC** hung in and contacted the running rail and became unbalanced.

RACE FOUR: CLASS 6 - DOMESTIC BRED - 1200 METRES

Prior to the start **HIDDEN CHAMPION** reared in the barrier and was a late scratching when it was deemed that the colt was not fit to take its place in the field. **HIDDEN CHAMPION** will be required to undergo a stall test prior to its next start. **NAPALSORI** was difficult to load in the barrier and must now undergo a stall test prior to its next start. Lee Shin Young (**ALL V**) was fined W100,000 for careless riding in that near the 150m she failed to make a sufficient effort to prevent her horse from shifting in when not clear of **KANUI BYEOL** which was crowded and eased out across its heels.

RACE FIVE: CLASS 5 - DOMESTIC BRED - 1300 METRES

GEUMBIT GALCHAE hung in when racing in the home straight and a warning was issued. Lee Jun Dong **(TOP MYEONGYE)** was fined W100,000 for careless riding in that near the 50m he permitted his mount to shift in when not clear of **NATALFIER** which was checked.

RACE SIX: CLASS 4 - FOREIGN BRED - 1700 METRES

Shim Seung Tae (**SASEONG**) was fined W20,000 for careless riding in that approaching the first turn he permitted his mount to shift in when not clear of **EMPEROR CAT** which was checked. **GIPPEUN SESANG** was slowly away (3L).

RACE SEVEN: CLASS 4 - DOMESTIC BRED - 1400 METRES

BEST SWING and **SUPER TIGER** were difficult to load in the barrier and must now undergo a stall test prior to their next start. A post race veterinary examination of **ORIGIN** did not reveal any abnormality and a swab sample was taken.

RACE EIGHT: CLASS 4 - DOMESTIC BRED - 1700 METRES

Jun Duck Yong (GLIDE MILK) was found to have ridden carelessly in that rounding the first turn he permitted his mount to shift in when not clear of VICTORIA CAPTIN which was severely checked. Jun Duck Yong's license to ride in races was suspended for one race day. A post race veterinary examination of BIRDIE HUNTER and THUNDER HILL did not reveal any abnormality and a swab sample was taken from each runner.

RACE NINE: CLASS 3 – DOMESTIC BRED - 1800 METRES

Jung Ki Yong (VICTOR HUNTER) was fined W40,000 for gripping the neck strap on his colt at the start which broke on jumping. As the gates opened **DREAMER** reared and it missed the start badly (4L). **DREAMER** will be required to undergo a stall test prior to its next start. A post race veterinary examination of **FINE STRONG** and **SUSEONG EQUUS** did not reveal any abnormality. A swab sample was taken from **SUSEONG EQUUS**.

RACE TEN: CLASS 1 – FOREIGN BRED – 2300 METRES

WIND KING was an early scratching when it was revealed that it had soreness to the inside (frog) of both front hoofs. A post race veterinary examination of

GAMADONGJA revealed the gelding to be lame in the off fore leg and it was sent to the KRA veterinary hospital for further examination. The results of those examinations will be reported at a later date.

RACE ELEVEN: CLASS 2 – DOMESTIC BRED – 1900 METRES

LIVE QUEEN missed the start (3L) and must now undergo a stall test prior to its next start. In the home straight **FEEL IT NOW** hung in and a warning was issued.
